Partners in Education Program

Sacred Foundations, Inc. (SFI) is supportive of other organizations, teachers, healers, etc. and building partnerships is an important part of creating a win win for all. We feel that a balanced spiritual community is created by inclusion, education, healing, understanding, acceptance, support and personal responsibility. We believe that each person must find his or her personal path to the Divine. As a part of this, we provide, partner with, and encourage programs and education that allow each person the discovery of the path meant for them. Through partnering with others, students have a greater opportunity to find courses that best meet their needs.

Those who wish to become a Partner in Education with SFI, and both parties feel this partnership is a good fit, SFI will review their course curriculum to see if their courses meet any of the requirements for SFI's Ministerial Credentialing program, Continuing Education for SFI Ministers, and the transferability of all SFI Degree Program Courses. Once approved, SFI will supply a list of approved courses and the requirements they meet.

Agreements between parties are as follows but may be adjusted to meet specific needs...

Referrals – 10% Student Referral Fee

SFI agrees to pay the Partner in Education 10% of the student's first course fee when referred to them by the Partner in Education.

The Partner in Education agrees to pay SFI 10% of the student's first course fee when referred to them by SFI.

Continuing Education

Partner in Education approved courses may be taken by SFI credentialed ministers to meet their annual Continuing Education requirement.

Ministerial Credentials

Partner in Education courses which are approved for SFI Ministerial Credentialing may be taken by SFI ministerial students to receive credit for their required studies.

Accredited Degree Program

SFI Degree Program students who have taken approved courses through our Partner in Education will receive full credit for those courses towards their SFI degree.

Marketing

The Partner in Education agrees to include its partnership with SFI in its marketing efforts. SFI markets its Partners in Education program to its students and on social media outlets. Chaplaincy:

- Required for most hospital chaplaincy program administrators
- Nurses and doctors appreciate having trained reverends on their palliative care teams
- Required in fields such as NAFC, National Association of Forensic Counselors certification in pastoral drug and alcohol counseling

Corporate:

- Occupations where working with people from different faiths
- A better understanding of global issues, human needs and perceptions
- A better understanding of various world religions, their spiritual essence, their similarities and differences, without bias and dogma

Personal:

- For better communication with others, appropriately in their own spiritual language, according to their spiritual beliefs
- To learn rituals from different traditions and to work with people with different spiritual beliefs
- Understanding brings more compassion, to come from another's point of view rather than what we are taught through the media
